



Purposes for registration:

1. To enable students to select courses that will help prepare them for the future while meeting their requirements for high school graduation.
2. To determine which courses will be offered and to plan the staffing for next year. For this reason, **all course selections are final.**

Registration Steps:

- Step 1:** Browse the course catalog tab on the website.
- Step 2:** Fill out each section of this registration worksheet. Select your required courses and write in the course name and numbers for your elective course choices
- There are some additional versions of core courses (**ML, SpEd**) described in the guide.
- Step 3:** Talk with your teachers and caregivers about your selections.
- Step 4:** Confirm that you have selected 7.5 credits. Remember, each course number = .5 credit
- Step 5:** You will use this worksheet to enter your course selections into StudentVue when the registration window opens. Remember, once course selections are entered into Synergy, they are final.
