

## What is Title I?

Title I is a federally funded program that provides extra support to schools to help students who need it most. The goal is to ensure all children have the opportunity to succeed academically, especially in reading and literacy.

## Meet The Teachers

Mrs. Kacy Leeth and Mrs. Gina Wyman will be working closely together. Mrs. Wyman is the Title I Dyslexia Specialist at Mohawk Local Schools. Mrs. Leeth is one of our Title I Paraprofessionals. She will be working with 4-6<sup>th</sup> grade students on reading skills, morphology and fluency.

**-Morphology** (understanding word parts like prefixes, suffixes, and roots)

**-Fluency** (reading with accuracy, speed, and expression).

## How Does Title I Support Reading?

- Small group or individualized reading instruction
- Extra practice with reading skills
- Access to specialized reading materials and technology
- Support from certified reading specialists and teachers
- Family engagement activities to support reading at home

## Who Qualifies for Title I Services?

- Students needing extra help with reading skills
- Students take the iReady test in the beginning of the year. If they receive a score showing not on track, they will be considered for Title I intervention.
- Services are provided at no cost and are focused on improving reading outcomes for all students.

## How Can Families Get Involved?

- Communicate regularly with your child's teacher
- Attend Parent/Teacher Conferences
- Attend Open House
