



2024-2025 COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT REPORT

As I reflect on the '24-25 school year that just concluded, I'm filled with deep gratitude for the incredible ways our community came together to support Stanley. It was a year of profound connection and commitment to our foundational values, an investment into our program and ongoing efforts in our school's approach to safety and security.

Academically, we dedicated significant focus to curriculum development and documentation, building directly on feedback from our accreditation. At all staff meetings, divisional time, and subject meetings, we created dedicated time, training, and space for these crucial efforts. This will allow us to better review redundancies, identify gaps, and strengthen both the horizontal and vertical alignment of our curriculum across all grades.

This past year also saw us taking continued strides in reinforcing the safety and security of our campus. We implemented important measures including a comprehensive two-hour training on Standard Response Protocol for all staff. We were able to invest in enhanced access controls throughout campus thanks to a generous donation, and we provided all faculty and staff with lanyards and key fobs, streamlining secure access while maintaining vigilance.

Our efforts in grounding ourselves in our values and reconnecting to our roots perhaps stood out most from this past year. We began the year by taking our faculty and staff to the two prior campuses that Stanley was on and hearing from alumni and alumni teachers about the early days and ethos that have shaped the school into the beloved place we all value. In October, we had nearly 600 people from across the world gather in our gym to honor the late Carolyn Hambidge, who was our founding Head of School. Stories from family members and staff created a truly positive and shared remembrance, and our students also planted daffodils, Carolyn's favorite flower, all around campus as part of family group activities. An endowment to support financial assistance was created in her honor. We also launched a new Alumni parent event in January which proved to be very successful, seeing outstanding engagement from alumni parents spanning multiple decades.

On the community engagement front, we also created a new TK-8 event, Septemberfest, which was a fabulous outdoor carnival led by our 8th graders and parent volunteers in a joyful atmosphere in the fall. Our spring fun run event led to our students earning a Gaga Pit for the school and a successful and entertaining Shindig auction and paddleraiser allowed us to get two new buses to add to our fleet to support all of our outdoor education experiences, field trips and sports programs which contribute to the whole child education of Stanley.

- Investing in facilities and possibilities of future Campus Master Plan projects, including taking steps in our Safety Audit such as adding access controls to the Hambidge buildings and locations throughout campus to elevate safety and security.
- Welcoming two new wonderful trustees, who bring valuable perspectives as an alum and current parent — expertise we will certainly lean on in the years ahead.
- Creating an Investment Committee which will provide an added layer of oversight over the school's endowment and investment strategy.

It has been a privilege to serve as Board President and to give back to a school that has so greatly inspired and shaped my own three children. I am grateful for the collaboration, care and optimism that define our community and for the trust you place in the Board's stewardship.
