Course Remediation Opportunity:

During exams, Course Remediation Room will be available for students who are eligible to complete work per classroom expectations and/or are at risk of failing the semester.

- Rooms will be supervised and available in the afternoons after students release at 12:20 p.m.
- Students seeking remediation opportunities must confirm the possibility of this option with their course teacher first to ensure they're able to complete remediation assignments for credit.
- Only course work that aligns with class expectations/deadlines and are approved by the teacher may be completed.

Students should speak with their teacher if they may be eligible and are interested in the opportunity.
