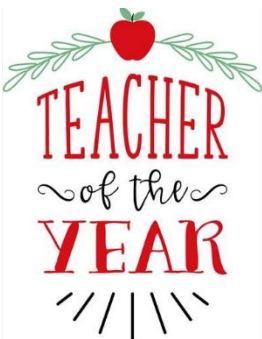


Volunteer Opportunity for International Night – Join Us!
