Call to Order

Also present were Superintendent Anna Sell, Business Manager Shannon Jepson. Joining via Zoom from Elliot and McMahon is Sue Diegaard.

Sheila Nagel moved to approve the agenda. Patti Kelly second. Motion passed 4-0.

Teacher Ryan Schneider was welcomed. There were no public comments and no communications.

Student Outcomes-Goals

Summative Report-Goal #2 Math was changed to: Student Outcome Goal 2 was changed to: OPS will increase the percentage of students which are proficient or above in Grades 3-8 and Grade 10 Math as measured by the ND state A+ summative assessment from 51% in May 2025 to 70% in May 2030. OPS scored an average of 11 points higher in each assessed grade than the average ND scores.

Goal Progress Monitoring Report-Goal #2 Math

GPM 2.1 Percentage of K-2 Learners at 65th Percentile on STAR Math

GPM 2.2 Percentage of 3-6 Learners at 65th Percentile on STAR Math. Both GPM 2.1 and 2.2 appear to be on track to reach our goals, as our historical data shows a trend of consistent and strong growth each school year.

GPM 2.3 Percentage of 7-10 Learners at 65th Percentile on STAR Math. After receiving our ND A+ results, we realized our GPM was not predictive of our performance. Despite our historical pattern indicating consistent drops from the fall to the spring, our performance in the last two years has been far above our goal indicating the potential for attainment of our spring goal.
