5. Applicant **must** submit an essay of around 500 words that includes how your participation in the performing arts has influenced you and how you plan to incorporate it into your future.
6. To be considered for the *eiMAPs* scholarship the applicant:
 - a) Applicant or their family **must** have been a member of *eiMAPs* for at least one year
 - b) Applicant **must** have **actively** volunteered for *eiMAPs*
