TUITION AND BOARDING FEES

Years 1-6 (12-18 years old)

€36,000 per annum

INCLUDED IN THE FEES:

- Tuition fees, Optional Extended Day Programme fees and an additional major elective subject (Years 4-6) *¹
- Registration fee
- Parents/Guardians Association subscription
- Lab fees/Consumables (Years 4-6); Chemistry/Biology/Physics/Art - IGCSE/GCE A Level/IAL
- IB DP School Administration fee
- Athletic Section fee
- GL Assessment (NGRT for Year 2), CAT 4 Level F (for Year 3) and PASS (for all Years)
- University guidance and application school service
- Uniform (1 piece per item; 2 extra short sleeve polo shirts, 2 extra-long sleeve polo shirts, 1 extra trousers/skirt and 1 extra bermuda)
- Books and pack of 10 notebooks
- Accommodation in the boarding facility *²
- Meals (full board) *³
- Laundry and cleaning
- Medical insurance valid in Cyprus (covering medical expenses up to €100,000 per annum) in addition to the 24-hour stand by General Practitioner *⁴
- Visa fees and related expenses
- Transportation (to school and back to the boarding facility on school days)
- Clubs fees up to €100
- Local school excursions as in the pupil calendar for the academic year (transportation cost only)

NOT INCLUDED IN THE FEES:

- Air tickets
- Damages refundable deposit of €300 (should the damage exceed €300 the pupil/parent/guardian will be liable for the outstanding balance)
- Accommodation during Christmas, Easter, July and August *⁵
- Meals during Christmas, Easter, July and August *⁵
- Laundry and cleaning during Christmas, Easter, July and August *⁵
- Transportation to school and back to the boarding facility during Christmas, Easter, July and August
- External examinations fees (other than GL Assessment) *⁶
- Clubs fees in excess of €100
- Any additional lessons requested which are not part of the standard curriculum offered by the school
- University application cost
- Non-compulsory activities organised by the school

- **Additional books and uniform items in case of loss**
- **Leisure expenses for activities, visits or excursions (estimated around €200 per month during school period and around €500 per month during school holidays: Christmas, Easter, July and August)**
- **Airport transfers (€70 per route) *⁷**
- **Airport transfers with escort for unaccompanied minors (€100 per route) *⁷**

PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

- **First payment: €6,000 down payment on application (continuing pupils need to reserve their places for the upcoming academic year by 31st of January)**
- **Second payment: €15,000 plus the damages refundable deposit of €300 prior to arrival. The Entry Permit is sent once the second payment is settled. Continuing pupils need to pay the second payment by 30th of June).**
- **Third payment: €15,000 by 1st of December**
- **If the fees are paid in full until 30 May 2026 then a discount of €1,000 applies**
- **Fees can be paid via bank transfer, debit/credit card or JCC Smart**
- **When transferring money it is important to clearly indicate the pupil's name, surname and class**

NOTES:

- **Our Year 1 corresponds to Year 7 of the UK educational system. Placement in the appropriate Year depends on the educational system a pupil comes from. The age and the academic performance are also taken into account.**
- ***¹ Optional Extended Day Programme (14:25-15:45):**
 - **Academic/Homework Support (Years 1-3):** The subjects taught are Mathematics, Science, English and Greek/Greek as a Foreign Language (GFL). Mathematics is taught two times a week whereas Science, English and Greek/GFL are each taught once a week. Pupils may choose to follow only one subject once a week.
 - **External Exams Support Lessons (Years 4-6):** The purpose of these lessons is solely to maximize pupil performance on their external exams.
 - **Afternoon Activities (all Years):** Pupils follow as many days as they wish or combined with Academic/Homework Support or External Exams Support Lessons.
- **Additional major elective subject: In Years 4-6 pupils have the option of choosing an additional major elective subject, such as French or Biology as part of triple science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology).**
- ***² Accommodation in the boarding facility: The above fees are for a 2-bed studio. The annual cost of 1-bed studio is €46,000 (subject to availability per payment schedule: first payment €6,000, second payment €20,000, third payment €20,000). Pupils can check-in as of 1st of September and they must check-out in June, a few days after their school/external examinations finish or right after their graduation ceremony. Alternatively, stay with a host family is possible.**
- ***³ Meals (full board):** some special dietary requirements may require additional payment.
- ***⁴ Medical Insurance:** New pupils are not covered during the first 30 days with the exception of life-threatening incidents.
- ***⁵ Accommodation/Meals/Laundry and cleaning during school holidays (Christmas, Easter, July and August):** €100 per night.
- ***⁶ External examinations fees:** The fees for the external examinations depend on the subject/level/examinations body, and are charged additionally.

- ^{*7} Airport transfers with or without escort for unaccompanied minors can be arranged by the school with taxi/transport companies cooperating with the school. The cost specified is an indication and is applicable to Larnaka International Airport.
- Visiting pupils (short term stay/integration programme): Pupils thinking of joining the school can register for a trial period (from 1 week up to 3 months) and the fees are €1,000 per week for 1-bed studio (subject to availability) or €700 for a 2-bed studio in the boarding facility. The fees cover the costs stated above as “included in the fees” except for some seasonal uniform items, books (used books are provided or some may be borrowed from the library), medical insurance (only Personal Accident and Public Liability insurance policies are included), visa fees and related expenses (only tourist visa is required), clubs fees and local school excursions fees.
- Fees are non-refundable. Once enrolled, the pupil/parent/guardian is liable for the payment of the full fees for that academic year.
- The above stated fees are reviewed annually.
- In accordance with current legislation (The Prevention and Combating of Money Laundering Act of 2007 (188(I)/2007), the school is not permitted to accept cash payments exceeding €10,000 per family, per academic year, regardless of the number of children enrolled. This applies to all financial transactions between the school and families, such as tuition and other fees, activities, external examinations, excursions and books (with the exception of the school canteen).
