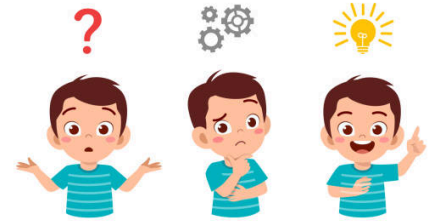
Jan. 14: PTO Dine to Donate

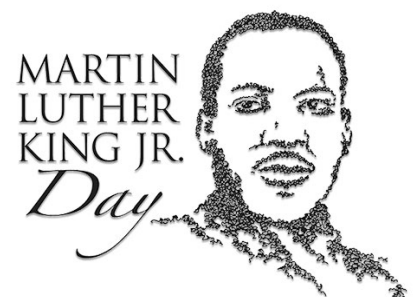

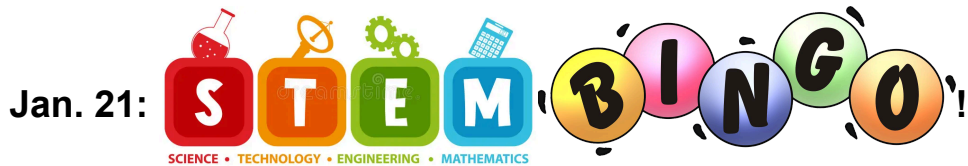
