Interview Expectations

To make a positive impression and present yourself professionally, you are expected to:

- Dress appropriately and professionally.
- Arrive early
- Bring a clean, updated résumé.
- Communicate clearly, confidently, and respectfully.
- Demonstrate knowledge gained from your ROP course.
- Show maturity, preparedness, and professionalism.

Professional Dress Guidelines

Wear clean, professional, appropriate clothing. Avoid revealing, tight, loose, or damaged clothes. Prepare your outfit in advance.

Arrive Early

Plan for traffic, parking, or delays. Arrive on time to show responsibility and respect.

Be Prepared

- Be ready to discuss your strengths and weaknesses.
- Review key learnings from your **ROP** course(s).
- Be prepared to explain how these concepts have positively impacted your learning and performance in other classes.
- Use appropriate terminology from your coursework to show understanding and confidence.

Be Alert

Sleep well the night before and eat a healthy breakfast to stay focused and energized throughout the day.

Demonstrate Social Skills and Professionalism

- Turn off your phone
- Maintain good posture—avoid slouching
- Make eye contact
- Think before you respond
- Avoid filler words such as “like” or “um.”

Be Genuine

Answer questions honestly. Do not say what you think the interviewer wants to hear.

Be Polite

Greet your interviewer by name, offer a respectful handshake (if appropriate), and say “thank you” at both the beginning and conclusion of the interview.
