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DESCRIPTION

The Crean Lutheran High School Thespian Troupe of the International Thespian Society seeks to recognize outstanding artistic merit, leadership, and academic achievement in students studying the theatre arts and to foster an appreciation for theatre as a true creative art form and one worthy of recognition and prestige.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Second-semester Sophomore or Junior who has earned the required one hundred hours (10 Points) of quality work in the theatre arts prior to Thespian induction
- Cumulative unweighted academic GPA of 3.20 or higher with an A average in all Performing Arts courses.
- Must be enrolled in a Theatre class
- Students should demonstrate leadership, responsibility, respect, trustworthiness, and citizenship
- No incidence of academic dishonesty
- Complete the International Thespian Society Application or Renewal Form by the deadline

MEMBER REQUIREMENTS

- Attendance at all International Thespian Society meetings that occur each semester
- Enrollment in a Theatre Course at Crean Lutheran High School each year in ITS
- Actively participate in theatre activities at school, in the community, or professional to accrue points towards Thespian Honors
- Lead by example on campus by following the outlined behavior expectations in the student handbook (*e.g. uniforms, attendance, Christ-like behavior*)

Students who submit successful applications, are accepted, and fulfill the requirements will be able to list the International Thespian Society on their college application or resume and be recognized for their accomplishments at graduation.
