ELECTION OF SCHOOL BOARD OFFICERS

The Milford School District Board of Education will hold an annual reorganization meeting in July of each year when the elections of the President, Vice President, and the installation of new members will be the first items of business.

Nominations will be made from within the Board. For election to office, a nominee must receive a majority vote of the entire Board membership. Should no nominee receive a majority vote of entire Board membership, the election will be declared null and void and nominations will be reopened.

In the event the office of President or Vice President becomes vacant between elections, the Board will use the method of election set forth above to select a member to fill the vacancy until the ensuing annual organizational meeting.

At each reorganization meeting, the Board will also designate the Superintendent as the Executive Secretary.
