### Data

- Previous grades- solid C from 2022-2025, was an unofficial D during covid ( 2020-21)
- Focus is to get to a B school- our data is trending in the right directions, been on the upward trend for the past few years
- There are 8 scoring components that are factored together to make a final score- we need 54 points to get to a b.
- Our goal for 3<sup>rd</sup> is 53%, 47% proficiency ELA, Math 55%, 50% Science.
- LG only count for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> because it is a gain from previous year. 55% ELA and Math LG, LQ LG ELA and Math 48%

**Clarke- PENDA- \$975- app to enrich students in science called PENDA learning- benefit students to remediate and enrich-**

Mrs. Schuld- ELA and math data we receive counts for 3-5. 1/8 of the school grade is science 5<sup>th</sup> grade- the science test is 3-5 test meaning they are assessed on standards from all 3 grade levels- Penda can help bridge the gap from previous grades and students can focus on learning the 5<sup>th</sup> grade standards not having to remediate from previous grades. All Title 1 schools had it 3-5 but there has been a restructuring. The funds have been allocated a little differently.

Question asked- does this just focus on 4<sup>th</sup> grade standards?- it can be below and above based on need- can go student by student to meet needs

Question- this is just for 4<sup>th</sup> grade now? We have seen it to be beneficial in 5<sup>th</sup> this year from use last year

Garcia shares how you can remediate and assign based on needs for different levels. These kids enjoyed it last year- it has features to meet accommodations. I see the value in getting this program. It will be a yearly thing depending on how the funds are allocated.
