



## **SY 25-26 Inclement Weather Plan**

To prepare Milford School District families for the potential of inclement weather this upcoming winter season, we would like to provide some specific information describing how instruction will continue should school closures be announced for SY 25-26.

### **Day 1 of school closure due to inclement weather:**

- This day will be considered as a traditional 'snow day' when students do not report to school and there are no required learning activities.

### **Day 2 and subsequent days of school closure for the same weather event:**

- The Milford School District will transition to asynchronous instruction.
- Should schools be open for employees, teachers will provide updates, reminders, and learning expectations to students and families using our standard communication platforms. Please ensure that you are familiar with the communication platform your student's teacher(s) uses such as Schoology, Talking Points, or others.

### **Asynchronous Learning Details:**

- There will not be any live instruction or synchronous activities during any school closure.
- Students in grades K-6 will bring home a paper-based learning packet designated to use for asynchronous learning at the beginning of each month starting with January and February. Packets for subsequent months will be sent home based on the forecast for any major weather events that could result in the closure of school.
- Students in grades 7-12 will receive their designated assignments through Schoology.
- In addition to these activities, families are encouraged to have their student read a book for a minimum of 30 minutes each day. This could be independent reading or having another family member read to your student, but in all cases, engaging directly with text is the best way to build upon reading and comprehension skills.

### **Additional Information:**

- The purpose of this plan is to prioritize the safety of students and staff while ensuring that learning continues during extended closures.
- Information on school closures and the transition to asynchronous learning as needed will be communicated as quickly as possible through the District's standard communication outlets including Talking Points and Infinite Campus in addition to social media accounts.

## **Plan para condiciones climáticas adversas del año escolar 2025-2026**

Para preparar a las familias del Distrito Escolar de Milford ante la posibilidad de condiciones climáticas adversas durante la próxima temporada de invierno, les proporcionamos información específica sobre cómo continuará la instrucción en caso de que se anuncien cierres escolares para el año escolar 2025-2026.

### **Primer día de cierre escolar debido a condiciones climáticas adversas:**

- Este día se considerará un "día de nieve" tradicional, en el que los estudiantes no asisten a la escuela y no hay actividades de aprendizaje obligatorias.

### **Segundo día y días subsiguientes de cierre escolar por el mismo evento climático:**

- El Distrito Escolar de Milford implementará la instrucción asincrónica.
- Si las escuelas permanecen abiertas para el personal, los maestros proporcionarán actualizaciones, recordatorios y expectativas de aprendizaje a los estudiantes y sus familias a través de nuestras plataformas de comunicación habituales. Asegúrese de estar familiarizado con la plataforma de comunicación que utiliza el maestro de su hijo, como Schoology, Talking Points u otras.

### **Detalles del aprendizaje asincrónico:**

- No habrá instrucción en vivo ni actividades sincrónicas durante ningún cierre escolar.
- Los estudiantes de K-6 recibirán un paquete de aprendizaje impreso para el aprendizaje asincrónico a principios de cada mes, comenzando en enero y febrero. Los paquetes para los meses siguientes se enviarán a casa según el pronóstico de eventos climáticos importantes que puedan resultar en el cierre de la escuela.
- Los estudiantes de 7.º a 12.º grado recibirán sus tareas a través de Schoology.
- Además de estas actividades, se recomienda a las familias que sus hijos lean un libro durante al menos 30 minutos al día. Puede ser lectura independiente o que otro miembro de la familia lea al estudiante, pero en todos los casos, interactuar directamente con el texto es la mejor manera de desarrollar las habilidades de lectura y comprensión.

### **Información adicional:**

- El propósito de este plan es priorizar la seguridad de los estudiantes y el personal, garantizando al mismo tiempo la continuidad del aprendizaje durante los cierres prolongados.
- La información sobre los cierres escolares y la transición al aprendizaje asincrónico, según sea necesario, se comunicará lo antes posible a través de los canales de comunicación habituales del Distrito, incluyendo Talking Points e Infinite Campus, además de las redes sociales.
- Si tiene alguna pregunta, comuníquese con la escuela o el maestro de su hijo.

### Premye jou fèmte lekòl akòz move tan:

- Jou sa a ap konsidere kòm yon 'jou nèj' tradisyonèl lè elèv yo pa prezante lekòl epi pa gen okenn aktivite aprantisaj obligatwa.
