



VOCAL MUSIC

Be prepared to:

- Sing a major scale on solfege (using *Do, Re, Mi, Fa, So, La, Ti, Do* when you sing it).
- Sing the first verse of “America” (*My Country ‘Tis of Thee*). Lyrics below. This must be memorized!
- Sing one prepared song of your choice. An accompanist will be provided if you provide sheet music for them. Auditions without accompaniment sheet music will be a cappella.
- Sight-sing a simple four measure melody.
- Hand in a written essay/statement (5-7 sentences long) explaining why you want to attend *School of the Arts*. **BE SURE TO WRITE ABOUT WHY YOU ARE INTERESTED IN VOCAL MUSIC!**
- Hand in a *Confidential Applicant Snapshot* from a past or current teacher.

What you need to bring with you:

- A copy of the sheet music for your prepared song.
- Your written essay/statement about why you want to attend *School of the Arts*.
- Your completed *Confidential Applicant Snapshot* (this may be mailed directly to SOTA AUDITIONS)

CHECKLIST FOR YOUR AUDITION:

- ✓ I have written my statement of why I want to study Vocal Music at *School of the Arts*.
- ✓ I have had one of my teachers fill out the *Confidential Applicant Snapshot*. My teacher has mailed this form directly to SOTA AUDITIONS through the district mail.
