River Valley Local Schools 2025-26 Online Day Plan

During 2025-26, River Valley Local Schools will implement Online Days after the 7th day for a calamity day.

A.) Overview: Online Day Plan:

- Once RV misses 7 days of school for Calamity Days, then days 8 - 10 will be online days. Students will be able to log in to Google Classroom and connect via Google Meet with their teacher during the hours outlined in section C below. The online day is intended, as much as possible, to include teacher-directed synchronous learning. This means teachers and students can interact, in real-time on a virtual learning platform using Google Classroom and Google Meet. However, this live interaction may be for a limited amount of time to answer questions or provide direct instruction.
- This document will provide an overview of the Online Plan. Specifics for each building and class will be provided by your child's Principal and their teacher(s).
- Online Days will operate on a 2-Hour Delay Schedule:
 - River Valley Middle and High School: 9:45 AM - 2:50 PM
 - Heritage and Liberty Elementary Schools: 11 AM - 3:40 PM

B.) Attendance Requirements & Expectations:

- Students will complete a daily attendance verification survey using their Google Credentials. This survey link will be provided through Google Classroom and/or ParentSquare.
- Students will be counted as Absent if this survey is not completed by 11:59 PM on the day of instruction.
- Excused Absences will occur for the same reasons as outlined in student handbooks.
- Parents and guardians are to ensure that their child is fully participating in the educational process. When a student is unable to participate in an Online Day, parent notes/doctor notes should be submitted. It is expected that students will be available to complete assigned tasks and participate in online instruction during the regular two-hour delay schedule hours of operation for their assigned building.

C.) Content and Delivery

- **Preschool-Grade 5:** Students will complete all assignments posted to Google Classroom for assigned classes. Teachers will be available to assist students, answer questions, etc. via Google Classroom and Google Meet between the hours of 11:00 AM - 12:30 PM & 1:00 PM - 2:30 PM. Teachers can also be contacted by email.
- **Grades 6-12:** Students will complete all assignments posted to Google Classroom for assigned classes. Teachers will be available to assist students, answer questions, etc. via Google Classroom and Google Meet between the hours of 10:00 AM - 11:30 AM & 12:00 PM - 1:30 PM. Teachers can also be contacted by email.

D.) Accessibility for students:

- Students with disabilities, English Language Learners, and students who may need additional supports or access to Intervention Specialists and services arranged by the Special Education Director and Principals. This information will be shared by the Principals, Intervention Specialists, and other Related Services (Speech, OT, PT, etc.) and may include specific times for students to connect virtually for these services depending on previously established calendars.

E.) Notifying parents, students, and staff:

- River Valley will use the Parent Square system and social media to notify staff, parents, and students that RV will be closed and using the Online Day Plan. Information may be shared via phone call, text, email, social media, and various news sources (online, radio, and television).

F.) Internet connectivity and Assignment Due Date:

- We realize some students may not have internet access to connect via Google Classroom/Meet. As the district approaches seven calamity days, Principals and Teachers will monitor potential weather systems and have students download assignments while in class at school to their Chromebooks. This will allow students to have access to the assignments even if they cannot connect to the internet. If a student can not access the required material during the Online Day, they have two school days after return to normal school to complete the necessary assignments and receive credit for the day.
- Parents will need to call or e-mail the school office to let them know their child(ren) does not have internet access so they will not be counted absent. All students will have two school days total upon the district's return to normal school to complete any assignments from an Online Day. This will allow the student to no longer be counted as absent on the Online Learning Day.
