


# NORTH THURSTON HIGH SCHOOL

In the early 50's Lacey and South Bay were still small unincorporated hamlets on the fringe on the Olympia School District. Each had it's own elementary school, but sent their ninth graders to William Winlock Miller High School. Miller High School, more commonly known as OHS, was the only comprehensive, public secondary school in the area. As these rural areas grew in population, parents became increasingly dissatisfied with their service contract with the Olympia School District. They decided to build and operate their own high school.


Neither South Bay nor Lacey could afford to build their own high school, but a plan was put before the people to combine the two districts and build one high school. The North Thurston School District was born. None of the original planners could have foreseen how their little district would grow. In the thirty plus years since the decision was made to build NTHS, this district has been one of the fastest growing in the state. Now it is the largest in Thurston County.

This rapid expansion has been costly to the tax payers. They have had to build as many schools in thirty years as some districts did in a hundred. Their burden has been even heavier because the northern part of the county does not have a base of industry to tax. Homes provide more children and fewer tax dollars than mills and plants.

In the early days of the district, this demanded that some buildings be put up with cost the first and only consideration. Thus the old North Thurston was an "economy model". Built for a maximum enrollment of 500, it could not handle an enrollment of 1200. Over the years classrooms were added, but the gym, cafeteria, and office all remained the same size and became increasingly crowded. Even the building of Timberline High School only offered a temporary rest from the problems of too many people in too little space.

Meanwhile time and economy construction were taking their inevitable toll. The old NT was a deteriorating building. It was hard to find a room that kept rain out or heat in. Built in a time





of cheap energy (stove oil at ten cents a gallon, sometimes less), it became a fuel consuming nightmare by 1983.

Finally the erection of new buildings slowed a little and the voters could afford to fix old NT. Even that ran into problems. The first architect opted for a plan of remodeling, and differences arose between the district and the architect-which may yet be litigated. A second architectural firm was called in and the district hired their own engineer. A thorough study by the new group revealed it would cost little more and be much more effective to build a new school rather than remodel the old one.

In April 1983 the new school was almost complete and we moved in. It is a beautiful building. The atmosphere is pleasant and it is an efficient place to learn. We are very proud of our new school and want to share it with you. Please come look through our yearbook and see us in your new building. This book is dedicated to you, the voters of the North Thurston School District, who have made this school and everything in it possible.

## Stadium in a Box

South Sound In  
Blam and Razer Out



In addition to the new school, 1983 also saw the completion of a district stadium. After 30 years of trying the structure was finally constructed using primary, year-to-year operating funds. Not nearly as grand as the complex at Olympia High School, the stadium was still a lot better than the old uncovered bleachers obtained from a Fort Lewis surplus sale in the 1950s. Three times the citizen's committee asked the voters to build a comprehensive sports complex that would include a new stadium, all-weather track, baseball and softball fields, soccer fields, and even a cross country course and vita course. On the first vote the issue failed by less than 100; on the second it failed by one vote. After a substantial defeat in the third election, the district decided the voters were willing to settle for something a little more common and South Sound Stadium was born. (The name was selected for its

neutrality. Blam and Razer just weren't catchy enough and wouldn't work if a third high school were built.)

The all aluminum structure arrived on trucks and went up so fast that some students called it stadium-in-a-box. Amazingly the structure was useable, though not quite complete for the first game, and was officially dedicated at the North Thurston Timberline game.

The value of the stadium soon became apparent as crowds increased dramatically at games—even with just about a 50/50 football season. The stadium is a proud tribute to the voters as well as legions of students and boosters who worked for many years to make it a reality. Over the years students and their parents were constantly raising money, selling candy bars, soliciting donations and even selling square feet of the field. In the end though, it took community and voter support to make it happen.

## Student Center




The student center is more than just a name on a map of the new North Thurston High School. It really is the center of student life at this school. The main attraction is the informal atmosphere with tables where students can just sit and chat. Before and after school it is not unusual to find 150 students quietly congregating there.

Of course the area has many formal uses too. Lunches are served, and the area is used throughout the day for meetings and large-group presentations.

In the evening the center is used for concerts, booster club meetings, parent groups, and even plays.


The only drawback to the area is that staging facilities are poor and during concerts the area in front of the trophy cases tends to become a hallway for people using the gym. In every other way though the center truly lives up to its name and is one of the nicest features of the school.

## Computers



Last year *Time* picked the computer as "Man of the Year." While the machine has a long way to go before it becomes student or teacher of the year, it is becoming an important part of North Thurston High School. It has been used for scheduling for over ten years, but now it is moving into the workroom and classroom.



Instruction on the computer is found mostly in the areas of math and bus. & office. The business people emphasize the use of word processing systems such as the Exxon, and software business systems on the Apple. They no longer teach beginning typing—now it is keyboarding.



The math department specializes in programming skills. Students write programs to solve problems of increasing difficulty. To cap the course, they write their own game complete with graphics. (The only place where games are allowed.)

More and more teachers are using the speed and accuracy of the computer to help with their grading and other routine tasks. Some students have mixed feelings about this. 
## F.F.A.







This year's staff got off to a late start. The advisor, Mr. Slosson, wasn't named until May of 1983. When the first contract proposals arrived from the publishers, it looked like this book would cost each student \$25.00. The staff decided to use this notebook format because it would keep the cost to about \$15.00 and it would allow later deadlines. First we met with the school administrators, A.S.B. officers, and a group of parents. They all agreed that \$25.00 was too much and that we ought to try this format at least once.

The staff began meeting weekly in July and decided that the big effort this year would be to show what a truly positive place North Thurston is. Sure! the new building helped attitudes and everyone was grateful. There is a more important story in this book, however. This is a place where good people come together and good things happen. The staff wanted to remind the students of that and we wanted to show the community too. Most of the criticisms you hear about public education are about ten years out of date. This school is good and it is getting better—every day.

To put this book together we exposed and processed more than 7,000 negatives. We made 2,400 prints and culled that down to about 1,500 final pictures (not counting mug shots). We coordinated with over 30 coaches and 25 activity advisors. There are undoubtedly errors and for those we apologize. It was a big job to do in only an hour a day (and more than a few weekends). It was a lot of work and a lot of fun. We hope it brings you a lot of good memories in the years ahead.


