
Everyone screaming, chanting, and waiting excitedly for that glorious moment when the football players smash through the Ram sign.






Math






Business procedures and office equipment are taught along with the language of the new highly technical machine called the computer.


Industrial Arts


Music Department

Agriculture



Traffic Safety




The students have an option to take the traffic safety course offered at our school. There are certain steps you must take to be enrolled in this class.




The teachers are only two of the great people here at N.T. We thank Mr. Dunn and Mr. Mendleson for being our teachers and having the patience to ride with us.





Counseling Center


Between meeting deadlines, selling ads, keeping the pop machines filled and wandering the halls this years annual staff has managed to keep themselves quite busy.




