

Classes for the 2026-27 School Year

During November and December, Oakmont students updated their Academic Plans in Aeries. The Academic Plans have been transferred to Course Requests for next school year (and can be seen in Aeries/Homelink under "Classes" and then "Course Requests"). During the months of January and February, every student will have a one-on-one meeting with their school counselor for academic planning and registration advising. Counselors will be reviewing student transcripts and course requests, and can make any needed updates to the 2026-2027 course requests or future Academic Plans at that time. These meetings will take place between January 12th and February 24th, during the school day.

Before January 12th, we ask that you do the following: Review the classes for next year in Aeries/Homelink under "Course Requests". Take notes on any final adjustments or changes that you'd like to make, and have the notes ready for your meeting. (Please do not email your counselor ahead of time with these changes.) Fill out the Google request form for your FOUR alternate courses. It is very important to have alternates selected in case of schedule conflicts and/or full classes. This form needs to be completed by January 9th at 11:55pm. Review the information about courses and programs that require applications: <https://oakmont.rjuhsd.us/resources/forms-documents>.

If you are planning to have a TA or Off Campus period next year, make sure to bring the completed form to your counselor meeting.

Parent Square, Aeries, Homelink Information

ParentSquare/Aeries/Homelink Users can fine-tune their notification settings for posts for each school and district. For General Announcements, you can select Digest, Instant, or choose to turn off notifications altogether (excluding Urgent Alerts and notices.) You can choose to receive email, text, and/or app notifications. We do encourage parents and students to turn on the Instant Text messages so that you can receive timely OHS information directly to your phone. Students will only receive text messages if we have their cell phone on file in Aeries. To learn how to set up your notifications, [please review this document](#).

Parents/Guardians also will receive weekly emails/texts from Aeries that send direct information about student grades and attendance. If texting alerts are set up this will go directly to your phone. Attention All Drivers!

Unauthorized Parking Will Result in Tickets and Towing!

To ensure safety and convenience of everyone we are strictly enforcing parking regulations.

Please be aware that parking in the following designated areas without proper authorization will result in a parking ticket AND your vehicle being towed at your expense. Possible revocation of parking privileges.

- Senior Spots - Painted parking spot and must include OHS parking pass. (Seniors Only)
- Staff Parking - Designated for authorized staff member's only. Clearly marked as STAFF in the parking spot. (Must have New OHS STAFF DECAL)
- Visitor Parking - Reserved for **Visitors only**. (Clearly marked Visitor)
- Handicap Parking - Must have a handicap placard.
- Other open spots - Must have a current OHS Parking Pass.

Operational Efficiency: Staff parking allows our team to perform their duties effectively.

Respect for Designated Areas: It maintains order and fairness for all.
