# Education Scholarship Trust Fund program

- Passed & signed into law in 2023
- Updated in 2025 and signed into law May 7, 2025
- ESA (Education scholarship/savings account) program
- Designed for low/middle income families - 200%-500% FPL





# How ESAs work



Funds are appropriated for the ESA program



Funds are loaded into each child's account



Parents access accounts online and can select the approved education service provider of their choice and upload an invoice



Funds are transferred to the education service provider on the student/parent's behalf



Students enjoy a flexible, customized education and new opportunities!

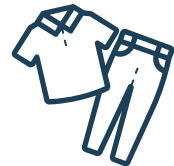

# Scholarship Distribution

Parents will submit invoices and browse education service providers through the ClassWallet portal

Distributed to parents' accounts in 4 quarterly installments

**Who is eligible?**

# To be eligible, a student must...



**Be a South Carolina resident**



**Will be in Kindergarten through 12th Grade and not exceed age 22**

THIS IS NOT A COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP



**Have a household income that does not exceed 300% of the federal poverty line**

For 2026-27 and beyond, increases to 500% FPL

# Scholarship Stacking

## NOT ALLOWED:



Receiving both ESTF and Exceptional SC





Receiving both ESTF and claiming the SC parental refundable tax credit for children with exceptional needs









BUT this does not affect scholarships given to you by your school or other outside scholarship programs.

# THERE'S NO SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY, BUT THERE ARE FOR WHEN YOU ARE USING THE SCHOLARSHIP.

## Students receiving ESTF may NOT:

-  Attend the public school that they are residentially zoned for
-  Homeschool under options 1, 2, or 3
  1. Through your local school district
  2. SCAIS
  3. Homeschool association

## BUT these school options are allowable:

-  Nonprofit private school
-  Public school that is not the one the student is residentially zoned for
-  Public charter school
-  Online or hybrid school
-  Microschool
-  Personalized education plan/  
at-home, parent-led education

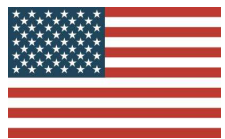

# DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

## PROOF OF RESIDENCY

SC Driver's license or government ID, utility bills, government issued mail (SNAP, TANF, voter registration, tax assessment, etc), mortgage statement

## PROOF OF GUARDIANSHIP

Federal tax return with kids listed as dependents, birth certificate, foster/adoption paperwork, divorce agreement, etc.

## PROOF OF INCOME

2023 or 2024 tax returns, Medicaid card or DHHS Medicaid letter listing Medicaid Member ID, or if you don't file taxes, other information on income

**IMPORTANT: Your application is not complete and is not processed until your documents are all approved**

*Documents are best processed as a scanned PDF, but taking a photo is ok as long as it is very clear.*

# What can you do now to prepare for your application, so you're ready to go when it opens?

**GET YOUR DOCUMENTS READY!!! HAVE THEM ON FILE AS PDF SCANS!**

## **PROOF OF RESIDENCY:**

- If you don't have a driver's license, go to the DMV to get a free SC Government ID card to submit for your proof of residency.
- If you don't have documents to get a government ID card, make sure you have some other way to prove residency - are you the parent listed on your home's utility bill? If not, get the account name changed. Do you have a voter registration card? There are lots of options.

## **PROOF OF GUARDIANSHIP:**

- Do you have your child's name listed as a dependent on your taxes? If not, do you have a copy of their birth certificate? You can request a new birth certificate copy if you cannot find it. Get that process started!

## **PROOF OF INCOME:**

- If you file taxes, make sure your 2023 or 2024 taxes are complete and ready to go, and that you have a copy of your whole 1040 that includes dependents' names.
- If your child is on Medicaid, make sure they have a recent (last 3 years) Medicaid letter from DHHS or a Medicaid card that shows their Medicaid Member ID. You can request a notice of approval letter from DHHS stating that your child is on Medicaid; go ahead and get one now and make sure the date is recent.
- If you don't file taxes and don't have Medicaid: find some other documentation for your income, such as paystubs for you and your spouse plus a letter from your employer.
