Discipline Matrix	Matt Halloran	10 min	Matt Halloran spoke to the Council about a new, transparent discipline matrix that the VSHS Building administrators are developing this summer. The purpose behind the matrix is to be able to have a method to determine appropriate consequences for discipline infractions that are consistent with all HS administrators. Additionally, the matrix will be communicated to staff so they are aware of discipline procedures and philosophy.
Updates to VCSD Code of Conduct	Group	15 min	District Council has been working on updates to the VCSD Code of Conduct. A summary of the changes in the Code was shared with all building principals, who were asked to get feedback on the changes from their respective Building Councils. The VSHS Building Council split into pairs to review the 12 sections of the Code of Conduct with each pair reviewing one or two sections. The Council then shared their opinions about the proposed changes to each Code section. The general feedback was that the proposed changes are written in student-centered language that is easier to understand than the previous Code of Conduct. The Council did wonder how the students will be made aware of the new Code of Conduct - Brian Siesto explained that the Code is sent electronically every summer during the summer “e-mailing” sent to students and families in early August.
