QUESTIONS RECEIVED

ADDENDUM 1:

- 1) Q: Does the bid need to be submitted in person on December 12th?

- 2) Q: The map labeled attachment "a-1" does not show an address. Is there any way you can provide the address information?

- 3) Q: Is prevailing wage a requirement, and if so, can a waiver on prevailing wage be given?

- 4) Q: The District has received multiple FOIA requests for our prior bid results.

- 5) Q: We noticed that there is a requirement for a bid bond included in the bid. Is this a mandatory requirement to be eligible for bidding?

QUESTIONS ANSWERED

ADDENDUM 1:

1) Q: Does the bid need to be submitted in person on December 12th?

A: Bid opening is Friday, January 9, 2026 at 3pm. We are requesting an “Intent to Bid” (page 19) be completed and submitted to us by Friday, December 12th, 3pm. You can email, fax, mail, or drop off the Intent to Bid. The Bid itself will need to be submitted either by mail or in person.

2) Q: The map labeled attachment “a-1” does not show an address. Is there any way you can provide the address information?

A: Attachment A-1 shows the Grant Community High School District Office – 25700 West Old Grand Ave., Ingleside, IL.

3) Q: Is prevailing wage a requirement, and if so, can a waiver on prevailing wage be given?

A: No, prevailing wage is not a requirement.

4) Q: The District has received multiple FOIA requests for our prior bid results.

5) Q: We noticed that there is a requirement for a bid bond included in the bid. Is this a mandatory requirement to be eligible for bidding?

A: Per page 14 bid security in the form of a Cashier Check will be accepted in lieu of a bid bond. The cashier’s check or irrevocable letter of credit from bidder’s bank on their letterhead signed by authorized bank officer, must be in the amount equal to 10% of the bid. The successful bidder’s bond will be retained by the District until a contract is signed and full delivery and installation is complete.



ADDENDUM 2:

6) Q: I noticed that the submission deadline has recently passed, but I wanted to check if you are still able to accept bids or if there is any flexibility for a late submission.

A: Per page 11, an Intent to Provide Bid form must be completed, signed and submitted no later than 3pm, Friday, December 12, 2025. Unfortunately, we are not able to waive this, as it is a bid requirement.

7) Q: I wanted to ask if a surety bond would be sufficient for the bid bond requirements?

A: Per page 14, a surety bid bond will meet our bid bond requirements.
