

## Registration Instructions for 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Grade/Four-Year Planning Guide

1. The Program of Studies for Grades 9-12 is available online at [www.svsd.net](http://www.svsd.net) (click on Academics and select 9-12). It is also accessible through a link on your SV Portal grade page.
2. Select English, math, science, history courses based on your pathway. Keep in mind prerequisites and teacher recommendation.
3. A completed schedule must have a minimum of 6 credits.

Study halls will be automatically added to available space in the schedule. Students who select Biology and Chemistry (1.4 credits) will have study halls opposite of the lab period. Students who do not want a study hall should schedule 8 traditional credits.
