Policy

Where it is reasonable and necessary to enable a student entitled or required to attend an elementary or a secondary school within the Addison Central School District, the district/supervisory union may furnish transportation on public roads to students to such students who reside within the district. Transportation schedules and routes shall be determined under the direction of the Superintendent. Alterations or changes in student transportation options may be made based on unanticipated or emergency situations.

The superintendent will establish routes and designated stops after considering both the safety of children and efficiency of operation. The superintendent will consider at least the following factors when determining routes and stops.

1. The age and health of pupils;
2. Distance to be traveled;
3. Condition of the roads travelled, and
4. Type of highway.

The superintendent may consider any other factors deemed appropriate when establishing routes and designated stops.


The superintendent shall submit to the school board for approval any contracts, leases or purchases necessary to maintain and operate transportation equipment, and shall include in his
