1. Call or visit Grace Network (276-638-8500) first thing to ask about emergency help with housing, utilities, and food.
2. Dial 2-1-1 for personalized crisis assistance referrals.
3. Apply for LIHEAP/EAP at DSS or via CommonHelp for utility relief.
4. Check eligibility for SNAP, TANF, and WIC by contacting your local DSS or using CommonHelp.
5. Reach out to Central Virginia Legal Aid if you need help with bills, rights, or housing issues.
6. If you feel unsafe or need shelter, call the Southside Survivor Response Center at 877-934-3576 right away.

Please be aware that the food banks & clothing closets may require ID to pick up items. You cannot pick up for someone else without them being with you and showing their ID.
