District Rental Facilities Policy Statement: The School Board encourages maximum use of school facilities by community groups and individuals.

Rules and Procedures for School Pool

- Please note these rules and procedures for this use; you are responsible for ensuring these guidelines are met.

Be Responsible:

- The individuals named on the facility use request and the group in whose name the facility use request is issued, are jointly responsible for the use of the facility.
- The individuals named on the facility use request and the group named on the facility use request, are jointly required to assume full responsibility for the personal injury of any participant or spectator.
- Competent adult supervision (21 years or older) must be provided by the group during the entire period of use.
- The group supervisor will be held responsible for compliance with the rules, general behavior and safety.

Two Locations:

- The pool is located in **Apollo High School at 1000 44th Avenue N.** Please use door 11 to enter and exit the facility. Men's, and Women's locker rooms are available. There is an entrance to the pool observation area.
- The pool is located in **Tech High School at 4200 33rd Street S.** Please use door 2 to enter and exit the facility. Men's, and Women's locker rooms are available. There is an entrance to the pool observation area.

General Information:

- Children under 48 inches will not be permitted to swim unless accompanied by a swimmer who is over the age of 12. However, if the child can swim the width of the pool unassisted this requirement will be waived.
- Admissions to the pool shall be refused to all persons having any contagious disease or infectious condition.
- Individuals must shower before entering the pool.
- Glass containers are not allowed in the pool, locker rooms, or pool balcony for safety reasons.
- Street shoes are not allowed on the pool deck.
- Running and rough play shall not be permitted. (Piggyback games such as "chicken fighting" shall not be permitted).
- Diving board rules:
 - One person on the board at a time.
 - One bounce per dive
 - No swimming in the diving area when the board is in use.
 - Catching swimmers is not allowed
- Remove all bandages, tape, and similar items before entering the pool. Gum chewing is not allowed in the pool area.
- Shorts are not allowed unless they are clean and hemmed.
- Do not visit with the lifeguards. Their job requires their undivided attention.
- The school and lifeguards will not be responsible for any articles lost or stolen. Please DO NOT leave any valuables in the locker rooms.
- A person should NEVER be thrown or pushed into the pool.
- Under no circumstances should any patron be allowed to use or be on the diving blocks.
- Any foreign object brought from home shall not be permitted unless special circumstances (make sure the object is disinfected).
- Soft cushion balls will be allowed on days when attendance is under 30 swimmers. These items must be used in a safe manner and not cause interruption to the other swimmers.
- No back dives or back flips from the diving board or side of the pool.
- Anyone who is guilty of continually violating these rules should expect to be expelled from the swimming pool area.

Additional Fees: A district supplied lifeguard must be on duty at all times during your event. Lifeguard fee is \$25 per hour. *Staff costs are billed accordingly by hours worked for your event.*

Cancellations: Notify the facility coordinator of any cancellations at least ten business days prior to the scheduled use or facilities staffing charges may be assessed.

Unauthorized Use Of Facilities Or Equipment: All facility and equipment use must be requested in advance and authorized by the facility coordinator, including ISD 742 staff use for any activity that has not been assigned to them by their supervisor. Unauthorized use of facilities and/or equipment may result in:

- Charges for use per facilities fee schedule.
- Charges for cleaning of facilities after use, plus any repair, supply or maintenance fees required due to use.
- A fine to be assessed by the facilities staff to the individual or organization for unauthorized use of facilities/equipment.

A lifeguard will be present throughout your use. If you need assistance, please contact them.
