- Recently added scholarships include:
 - **Horatio Alger Association Scholarships (for both juniors and seniors):** The [Horatio Alger Association](#) provides financial assistance to students throughout the nation who have financial need, demonstrate integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity, and are determined to succeed. High school juniors and seniors who demonstrate financial need (\$100,000 or lower adjusted gross family income) and are United States citizens are encouraged to apply for both their National and State Scholarships. Deadline for seniors: February 15, 2026 at noon. Deadline for juniors: March 1, 2026 at noon.
 - **Armstrong County Community Foundation Scholarships:** Over 40 different local scholarships are available for high school seniors on this website, including the [Armstrong County Technical School Scholarship](#). Students must create an account, complete, and submit the Universal Application. Once the Universal Application is submitted, the student will receive prompts for additional scholarships they may be eligible for. Please complete the additional information required for each of those scholarships. Deadline: February 16, 2026
 - **DEWALT Trades Scholarship:** For students currently enrolled or accepted to a post-secondary school or training program and pursuing a high demand skilled trade. Their list of high demand skilled trades can be found on the scholarship application. Deadline: February 28, 2026
 - **PA Elks Association Career and Technical Education Scholarship:** Available to seniors who are residents of PA and plan to pursue vocational/technical training in an accredited post-secondary school that will result in a certificate, diploma, or associates degree. 10 male students and 10 female students will receive a one time \$1,500 scholarship. Deadline: March 31, 2026
