

## DROP-OFF, PICK-UP, & PARKING LOT INFORMATION

We have seen an increase in traffic during peak hours (drop-off & pick-up),

Please review important safety information below:

### Inside Parking Lot

- NO BLOCKING entrances or exits.
- NO CURB PARKING/STOPPING, including preschool drop off.
- PARK IN DESIGNATED AREAS if you need to drop-off your student.
- WAIT FOR CROSSING STAFF before letting your student out of car.
- HANDICAP PARKING PLAQUE is needed to park in designated area.
- USE CROSSWALK inside parking lot when crossing.
- OBEY traffic staff.
- DO NOT SPEED!

### On The Street

- NO BLOCKING entrances, exits, emergency areas, or ramps
- USE CROSSWALK when crossing the street.
- PARK IN DESIGNATED AREAS if you need to drop-off your student.
- NO DOUBLE/SIDE PARKING.
- NO U-TURNS, arounds school area.
- OBEY traffic staff.
- DO NOT SPEED!

We will be working with our Safety Offices to ensure safe traffic control.
