Family Membership Fee

Pursuant to the by-laws of the Society, each Parent (as defined therein) with at least one child registered at the College will become a member of the Society by executing this agreement and remaining in compliance with the terms hereof.

It is standard common practice among independent schools to incorporate a Family Membership Fee into the admissions process. At WIC, it is a one-time, non-refundable fee of \$3,500 per family or \$2,000 for one student entering Senior High School. It is paid at the time of enrollment and extends thereafter to all siblings who qualify for the College's program.

Capital Improvement Fee

To ensure the continuous improvement of the facility, each family is levied a one-time, non-refundable, Capital Improvement Fee (CIF) of \$3,500 paid at the time of enrollment. The CIF extends thereafter to all siblings who qualify for the College's program.

School Supplies and Activity Fees

School supplies are the responsibility of the student, as many courses require specific materials. Until teachers have provided specific supply lists, a binder with loose leaf paper will suffice. Activity fees are collected for items such as athletic teams, International Travel, camps, trips, merchandise, etc. Mandatory fees for Grade 9 Celebration and Grade 12 Graduation will be invoiced separately.

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

To support learning, WIC students are expected to bring their own devices (BYOD), at their expense. Please refer to the information found on the WIC Website under the myWIC New Student Portal.

Students will be responsible for maintaining their own device including charging and installing virus protection. Students will be expected to comply with all class and school rules while using personal devices, per the Technology Responsibility Agreement and Social Media Responsibility Agreement forms.
