

APSB Primary District Goal

By May 2026, Ascension Public Schools will remain an A district and increase the District Performance Score.

- **ACHIEVE** - We will increase the percentage of students scoring Master or Advanced on all statewide assessments, including LEAP 2025, LEAP Connect, ELPT, ELPT Connect, and DIBELS by 4%.
- **GROW** - We will increase the percentage of students meeting their growth goals by 4%.
- **THRIVE** - We will increase the graduation rate by 2%, nationally recognized exam passage by 4%, and college and career acceleration by 4%.

Donaldsonville Primary School Goal

By May 2026, Donaldsonville Primary School will remain a C and increase the percentage of students scoring on or above benchmark by 4% through a focus on increasing teacher knowledge of students in order to meet student needs.

- DVPS will increase the percentage of students in grades K-2 scoring on or above benchmark level from 61% to 65% as measured by the end-of-year DIBELS 8 literacy screener.
- 80% of students in grades K-2 will meet their individual growth goals on grade-specific Q4 ELA benchmark assessment.
- 80% of students in grades K-2 will meet their individual growth goals on grade-specific EOY cumulative Math benchmark assessment.

Donaldsonville Primary Focus Areas

1) Literacy:

- ECH students reaching individual TSG literacy standard goals will grow from ___% to 90%.
- K-2nd grade students reading on grade level as evidenced by DIBELS 8 will increase from 61% to 65%.
- 80% of K-2nd grade students will meet their individual goals on literacy screener
- 80% of K-2nd grade students will meet their individual goals on Q4 ELA benchmark assessment.

2) Numeracy:

- ECH students reaching individual TSG numeracy standards will grow from ___% to 90%.
- 80% of K-2nd grade students will meet their individual goals on the APSB Cumulative Math Assessment.
