Certainly, prudent financial management plays a role in this, but the main reason we've been able to refrain from raising tuition is due to the generosity of those parents who support our Annual Fund and Endowment. Their Christian charity helps sustain our mission for all students and we invite you to join in their generosity if you have not already done so in creating a significant impact to each of our saints.

Next year will see no tuition increase but we are instituting a new security and facilities fee of \$200.
