Elected Dana Foley Temporary President.

Heard Certificates of Election read aloud.

Heard Oaths of Office administered to newly elected board members David Comalli, Katrina Filiatrault, Daniel Kimicata, and Amanda O'Connor.

Heard Public Comment about agenda items:

1. Marlene Pray spoke about students sharing their experiences at school, belonging and kindness, escalations of bullying, clubs and policies, the Rainbow Room, raising Pride flags at all schools and administration buildings, school library books, respecting pronouns, providing training for staff, and making schools safe for students.

Heard Public Comment:

1. Elizabeth Tolis spoke about Unified Sports in Central Bucks, athletic points approved at last month's meeting, the value placed on sports, and athletic points and stipends for coaches.
