Livermore High School's 2026-2027 Bell Schedule

LHS will follow a Modified Block Schedule, where students are enrolled in six class periods.

Anchor Days (Monday, Tuesday, Friday): Students attend all classes (1st–6th period).

- Start Time: 8:30 AM
- End Time: 3:10 PM
- Class Length: 55 minutes

Block Days (Wednesday & Thursday): Longer class periods for deeper engagement.

- Wednesdays: Periods 1, 3, 5 + CAP (Cowboy Advisory Period)
- Thursdays: Periods 2, 4, 6 + CAP
- Class Length: 95 minutes

Optional A & B Periods:

- A Period: 7:17 AM (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday)
- B Period: 4:23 PM (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday)
