Special Education Presentations at the Expo

Families are invited to attend one or more of the following presentations, where staff will review program structures and answer questions. All sessions will include time for Q&A.

RSP (Resource Specialist Program)

5:30–6:00 PM, Q&A to follow
Room 6 – Music Building

SDC (Special Day Class)

5:30–6:00 PM, Q&A to follow
Room 8 – Music Building

ESN, CE, and SDC Mod Programs

6:00–6:45 PM, Q&A included
Room 7 – Music Building

These sessions are optional but strongly encouraged, as they provide an opportunity to hear directly from program staff and better understand supports available at LHS.

Course Registration & Special Education Programs

Course registration for students with IEPs may look slightly different than for students in the general education program. Some courses and supports—such as Academic Support or program-specific classes—are not visible in the online registration portal and will be adjusted manually after registration closes to ensure schedules align with each student’s IEP.

Staff will be available at the Expo to help families:

- Understand how course selections align with IEP services
- Navigate differences between general education and special education scheduling
- Ask questions specific to RSP, SDC, ESN, CE, or SDC Mod programs.
