Scheduling timeline for all students for the 2026 – 2027 school year

1/6 – 1/21: Teachers enter recommendations and lock them into students' course requests

1/7: Students receive Course Selection Guides in homeroom

1/7 at 6:30 PM: Counselors host scheduling presentation for parents

1/12 – 1/15: HS Community Period presentations / Recordings will be made available for 8th grade students

1/21 – 1/22: 8th grade students enter course requests in StudentVUE

1/23 – 1/26: 9th & 10th grade students enter course requests in StudentVUE

1/27 – 1/28: 11th grade students enter course requests in StudentVUE

2/6 – 2/13: Student Course Request Verifications uploaded into StudentVUE / ParentVUE for students & parents to review / Students/parents may make changes to the requests that were submitted

Mid-May: Completed student schedules for the 2026-2027 school year available in StudentVUE/ParentVUE

June 1 – August 1: **Final opportunity to submit course request changes for the 2026-2027 school year**
