

## **SENIOR PRIVILEGES- SPRING SEMESTER 2026**

Seniors with a **1st or 9th-period study hall** may arrive late or leave early with parent permission. Please note that schedule changes will not be made to accommodate the request for senior privileges. Transportation is the student's responsibility.

**Please note that senior privileges will begin on Thursday, January 22, 2026. Seniors are not approved to start using senior privileges until the permission form is received. If you attempt to use senior privileges before the permission form is received, you may be issued a detention, and senior privileges may be denied.**

The Senior Privileges- Spring Semester 2025 form is linked below and available online (linked on the UHS website under For Students). Please review the rules and regulations and complete the application using the link below. **Students with a blended course period 1 or period 9 DO NOT need to complete this form.**

### **Senior Privileges Rules and Regulations**

1. Students eligible for late arrival must arrive at school and sign in at the Main Office **before** the bell at 8:49 am that ends 1st period. Signing in at the main office after the 8:49 am bell without a valid reason will result in an unexcused tardy. Continued unexcused lateness can result in discipline and the possibility of the loss of Senior Privileges.
2. Failure to sign in at the main office will result in you being marked unexcused absent from school. Signing in is the **ONLY VERIFICATION** we have to make sure you are on time and present.
3. Students must use the main entrance at the front of the school to enter the building. Students must sign in at the main office upon arrival. Students are not permitted to sign in other students.
4. Students eligible for the early release privilege must leave school property until the school day is over. They may not remain on campus, even if they are involved in an after-school activity. Students who choose to stay on campus must report to their scheduled study hall.
5. Students may not disturb classes that are in session while entering late or leaving early.
6. Students will enter and exit the campus in an orderly, prompt, and safe manner.
7. Disruptions while entering or leaving the building will result in a suspension or loss of these privileges.
8. Decreased academic performance or disciplinary infractions during the normal school day can result in the suspension or loss of these privileges.
9. When UHS is on an altered schedule (i.e. weather-related delay or Assembly schedule) students are responsible for knowing the adjusted arrival time.
10. Students with senior privileges 1st period should report to the end zone (adjacent to the student parking lot) for attendance in the event of a school evacuation.

A parent/guardian electronic signature is required on the permission form. Students must complete the form with a parent/guardian.
