Residency Determination Students #28630 and #31400

Motion by Nicholas Rosato, second by Kelly Bonapfel

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:38-1 and N.J.A.C. 6A:22, the Kingsway Regional School District must ensure that all students enrolled are legally domiciled within the District; and

WHEREAS, the District conducted a residency investigation which concluded on October 16, 2025, finding substantial evidence that Students #28630 and #31400 reside at 452 West Broad Street, Gibbstown, outside the Kingsway Regional School District; and

WHEREAS, a Notice of Initial Ineligibility was issued on October 20, 2025, and Ms. Holmes requested an appeal hearing; and

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2025, the Board convened a hearing in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:22-4.2 to review evidence and hear from Ms. Holmes; and

WHEREAS, after careful review of the investigative report, testimony, and submissions, the Board finds that Students #28630 and #31400 are not domiciled within the Kingsway Regional School District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board affirms the administration's determination that Students #28630 and #31400 are ineligible for tuition-free attendance, and directs the Superintendent to issue a Final Notice of Ineligibility and Removal pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:22-4.3; and



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Ms. Holmes shall be advised of her right to appeal this decision to the Commissioner of Education within twenty-one (21) days, during which time the students will remain enrolled tuition-free; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon exhaustion of appeal rights, the District reserves the right to seek tuition reimbursement for the period of ineligible attendance as authorized by N.J.S.A. 18A:38-1(b).
