WHAT IS YPSL?

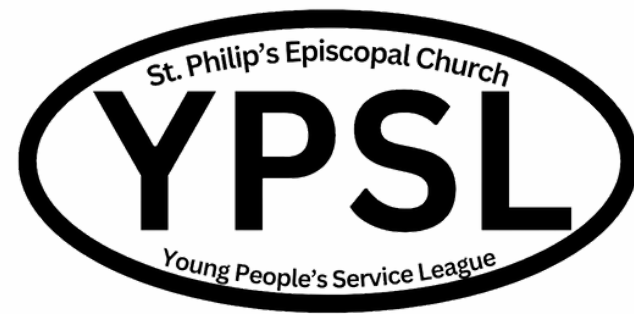
YOUNG PEOPLE'S SERVICE LEAGUE
