



The following report fulfills the district’s requirement to semi-annually provide the Board of Education President a written summary of all alleged/reported and confirmed incidents of bullying and harassment. This memo will be posted on the district website under Public Notices.

The following table shows the number of alleged/reported and confirmed incidents of bullying and harassment that occurred in the Marysville Exempted Village School District from June 1, 2025, through December, 2025.

In order to support students, all alleged/reported incidents were investigated, and appropriate action was taken no matter if they were confirmed as bullying/harassment or not.

We will continue to monitor the frequency of such incidents so we are able to reflect and take appropriate steps in an effort to proactively decrease the amount of incidents moving forward.

Bullying means any intentional written, verbal, graphic or physical act OR electronically transmitted acts that a student or group of students exhibited toward another particular student more than once and the behavior both:

- Causes mental or physical harm to the other student and
- is sufficiently severe, persistent or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening or abusive educational environment for the other student.

Harassment is defined as: Unwelcomed AND sufficiently severe or pervasive to alter the conditions of education or create an abusive, intimidating, hostile or offensive school environment.
