



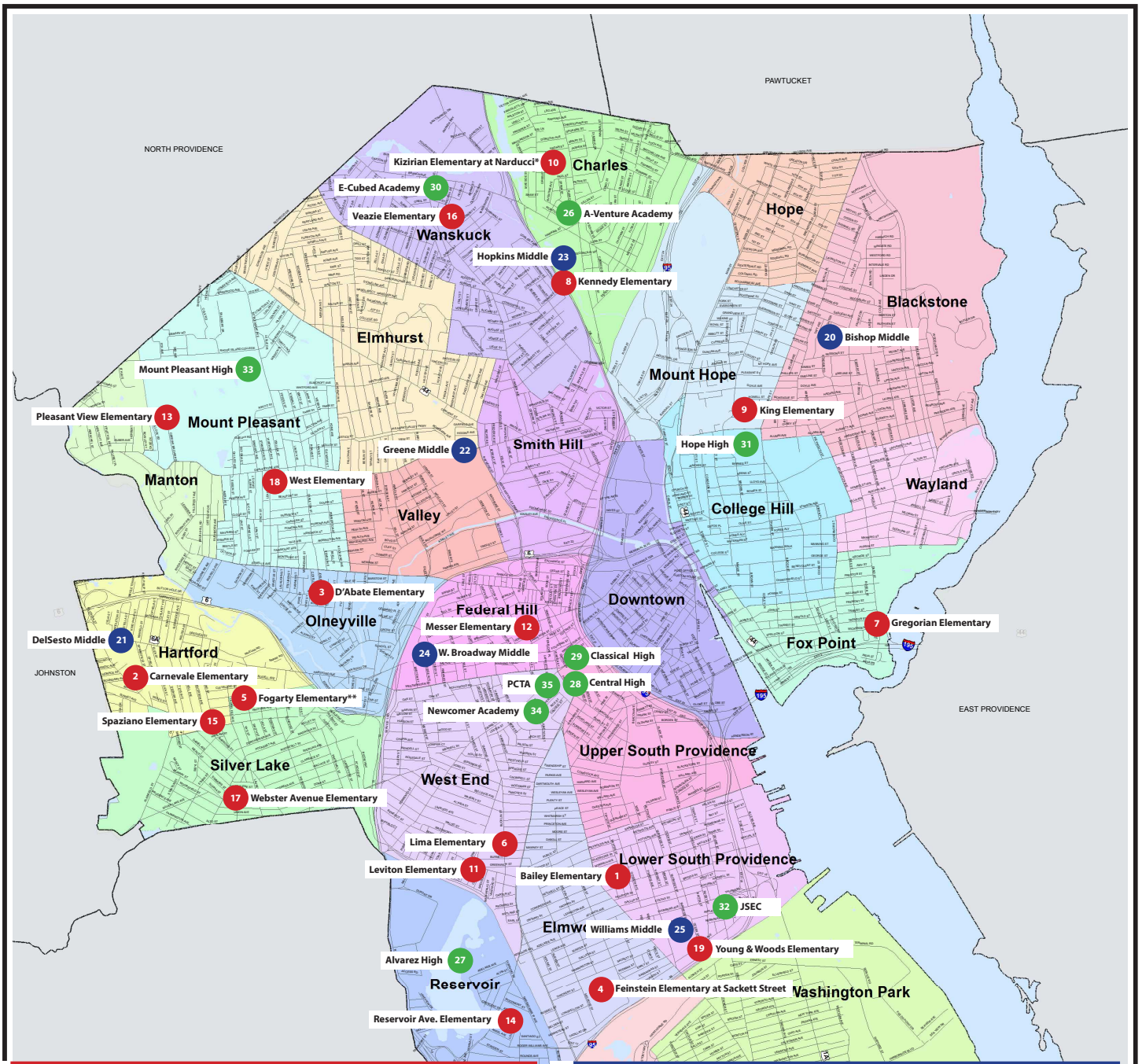

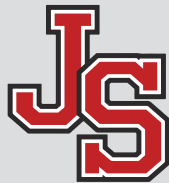

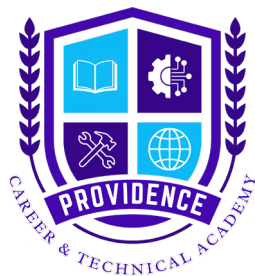

If you have a Skyward parent portal, please log in with your username and password and use the New Student Online Enrollment option to submit a registration.

Important: When you register, you will be asked to upload copies of some key documents. Please scan or take a picture of these documents with your phone and upload them to the portal.

The following documents will be needed for the registration process:

- **Student Age Verification Document:** Original birth certificate, passport, residency card, OR I-94
- **Parent/Guardian photo identification**
- **Immunization Records**
- **Physical Exam form**
- **Proof of Providence Residency:** Provide one of the following: Utility bill (not a cell phone or Internet bill), pay stub, lease, bank statement-all dated within 60 days of registration
- **School records:** Most recent report card (Grades K-8) or Official High School transcript (Grades 9-12)
- **Students with special education services:** All current Special Education paperwork
- **Tuberculosis Screening Test:** Students who have traveled outside of the United States for more than 90 days or who were born outside of the United States are required to show proof of tuberculosis screening.



***Please note that some students may require testing to complete the registration process.*



KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Every child who is five years of age on or before September 1st of each school year shall be eligible to attend kindergarten. Kindergarten registration opens in February.

- The Kindergarten lottery registration deadline is in May each year. Kindergarten placements for are sent to families in June.
- If you missed the lottery deadline, it's not too late to register! Please register as soon as possible.

RI PRE-KINDERGARTEN

INTEGRATED PRE-KINDERGARTEN

It is an integrated classroom where students needing specialized services learn and grow alongside their peers. Dual Certified teachers follow the Creative Curriculum and schedule. Full day and half day programs are available.

The district uses a lottery system to assign seats to each school. To participate in the lottery families will need to submit their choices in February. School choice forms are distributed to families in January via ParentSquare and the lottery placement is announced late March.

Placement preference will be given to:

- Fifth grade students with an older sibling enrolled in a particular middle school for the fall.
- Neighborhood schools. (80% of school seats are reserved for students within 1.5 miles from home)
- If a student does not have two schools within the 1.5 mile radius, the two closest schools count as neighborhood schools.

Students who submit choices or register after the initial deadline are not eligible for the lottery and will be assigned after all of the lottery students are placed.

EXAM AND APPLICATION SCHOOLS

Some schools may require an entrance exam or are application schools and do not participate in the school choice lottery.

The **Career and Technical Education (CTE)** admissions process for CTE programs begins in the fall of a student's 8th grade year. Providence has one full CTE high school, Providence Career and Technical Academy (PCTA), and additional CTE programs offered at many other high schools. The application deadline is January 12. The online application and additional information can be found at www.providenceschools.org/OCTE.

Students wishing to attend **Classical High School** in the 9th grade should begin the admissions process by contacting their guidance counselor. Classical High School is a college preparatory school with a selective, exam-based enrollment process. The High School Entrance Exam is conducted at Classical High School in October.
