TEACHER BILINGUAL

DESCRIPTION OF POSITION

To comply with the components of the District bilingual programs and to provide each student with an instructional environment favorable to learning and personal growth; as well as develop intercultural appreciation and Spanish/English skills necessary for the achievement of a good foundation for an elementary school education.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITY

- Provide students with an elementary education curriculum presented in combinations of Spanish and English.
- Develop lesson plans and instructional materials in order to adapt the curriculum to the language needs of each pupil.
- Provide experiences that will enhance the student's appreciation and understanding of other cultures.
- Provide language experiences in Spanish and English to facilitate acquisition of basic language skills.
- Design and maintain an attractive and meaningful cross-cultural environment.
- Communicate with school staff in coordination and articulation of the bilingual program.
- Continue formal education to improve understanding of instructional methods needed to enhance a bilingual curriculum.
- Ability to coordinate program with other federally funded projects such as Early Childhood Programs.

CREDENTIAL

Valid California Teaching Credential authorizing service to teach K-8.

EDUCATION

Evidence of University/College level courses related to bilingual education.

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS

Bilingual fluency in Spanish.

Such other qualifications as the District may find appropriate and acceptable

SUPERVISION

LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

Possession of a valid California Motor Vehicle Operator's License.

Condition of Employment

Insurability by the District's liability insurance carrier.

Physical demands

Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus.

Work Environment

The work environment characteristic described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee occasionally works in outside weather conditions.

The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.
