High School Diploma (HSD)

The High School Diploma Program is a **FREE** independent study program. Prospective students, with all previous high school transcripts, first schedule a meeting with a counselor at www.oxnardadulthood.us. After meeting with a counselor, students will meet with their assigned teacher for course assignments and online access. Students can work online, in the ABSE Classroom or a combination of both. Instructors closely monitor students lessons and exams, and provide tutoring in problem subject areas. Students usually work on one class at a time and work at their own pace. Textbooks can be purchased or borrowed with a deposit at the school office for home use. This program offers continuous enrollment throughout the school year. **New and returning students must take the CASAS pre/post test before starting classes to determine course placement, academic goals and record progress.**

High School Equivalency (HSE)

This **FREE** program helps prepare students for the HiSET exam offered at Oxnard Adult School. Each participant studies under the supervision of a teacher who supports the students in identified problem areas to gain the skills needed to pass the 5 subject test. This is an open-entry program and students may register at any time during the regular school semester. The program has flexible hours and allows students to contact their assigned instructor when it is most convenient for them. Students may qualify for test vouchers after 40 hours of program time towards the cost of the HiSET exam. **New and returning students must take the CASAS pre/post test to determine course placement before starting classes, academic goals and record progress.** Instructor and Section are determined at time of enrollment.

HSE Prep Spanish - Equivalencia de preparatoria en español

The High School Equivalency Test (HiSET®) allows students to earn a California state issued High School Equivalency Certificate. The HiSET® High School Equivalency Certificate is considered the equivalent of a High School Diploma and is recognized throughout the United States, Canada, and Puerto Rico. - ◆ Name on ID **must** be identical to the name on registration (excluding accents). If it doesn't, you may not be allowed to test, or your scores may be canceled after you take the test.
- ◆ **Bring printed HiSET registration page and a valid ID**, which can be California ID, DL, military ID, passport or any ID issued by a government to Oxnard Adult School Office and register for the HiSET Exam. No phone photos. Originals only. No drinks or snacks allowed in the testing room.

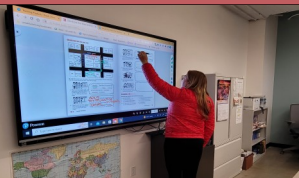

Registered Pharmacy Technician

Pharmacy Technician Education/Training Program Recognized by PHARMACY TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATION BOARD (PTCB) and NATIONAL HEALTHCAREER ASSOCIATION (NHA).

The curriculum meets the requirements for licensure with the State of California Board of Pharmacy and prepares the student to take the PTCE/ExCPT NATIONAL EXAM. **This 240-hour Hybrid (online/in-person)** program prepares students to work in insurance company, hospital or pharmacies (chain/independent). Get hands-on training with local pharmacies (chain/independent) thru our EXTERNSHIP program. Curriculums include learning top 200 drug brand/generic/class names, critical math functions/calculations, Federal Law requirements, patient safety, order entry/process and functions/duties for pharmacy technician.

Prerequisite: 18 years of age or older; must have a US high school diploma or HSE certificate (GED or HiSET). Foreign high school diplomas are welcomed as long as they are translated into English by an accredited agency.

Externships follow completion of course. Live scan required. No felony convictions. Students may be drug tested at externship site.

National exam prerequisites: High School Diploma or equivalency; no felony convictions. Additional fee of \$129 (as of June 2022)

Eligible students may qualify for an externship (120 hrs.)

The Integrated Education and Training (IET) course for adult education is designed to provide English Language Learners (ELLs) with a comprehensive learning experience combining basic skills education with workforce training. The course integrates three key components: adult education and literacy activities, workforce preparation activities, and workforce training. This approach gives students the skills and tools necessary to succeed in the job market, improve their employability, and achieve their career goals.

Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) **Coming Soon**

Nursing assistants provide basic care for patients in hospitals and long-term care facilities. This hybrid course combines lectures and labs to teach theory and clinical skills based on state-required curriculum. Students learn nursing skills and procedures for patient care in hospitals, nursing facilities, or home settings. Training includes resident care, vital signs, nutrition, emergency procedures, and rehabilitation. After completing the course, students must take the state certification exam. The course is approved by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) and meets Title 22 regulations. For certification details, visit www.CDPH.ca.gov.

Clinical Requirements:

Fall Registration Starts Jun 16

- Passing the CNA entrance exam.
- Must be 18+ years old and proficient in English.
- Social Security or tax ID number, background check, medical exam, vaccinations (including Covid-19), drug screening, government-issued ID, CPR, and TB test.
- Ability to lift 50 pounds with good body mechanics.
- Additional drug screening may be required. Other clinical requirements may apply.

California has the largest number of older adults in the country and will need an additional 275,000 direct care workers by 2026. Certified Nurse Assistants (CNAs) and Home Health Aides (HHAs) are crucial in nursing care and community facilities, often serving as primary caregivers. LeadingAge California® received over \$25 million from the California Department of Health Access and Information (HCAI) for The Gateway-In Project®, aiming to add 2,700 CNAs and HHAs through training and job placement. This program will help address the workforce shortage in healthcare for older adults by offering training, support, and career incentives.

Online CTE Certificated Programs

Certified Paralegal - In this online course, you will train for a career as a paralegal. You will learn how to fulfill the standard duties associated with this vital role. By course completion, you will be prepared to sit for and pass the Certified Paralegal (CP) exam.

These uniform complaint procedures (UCP) are used to investigate and resolve complaints regarding:

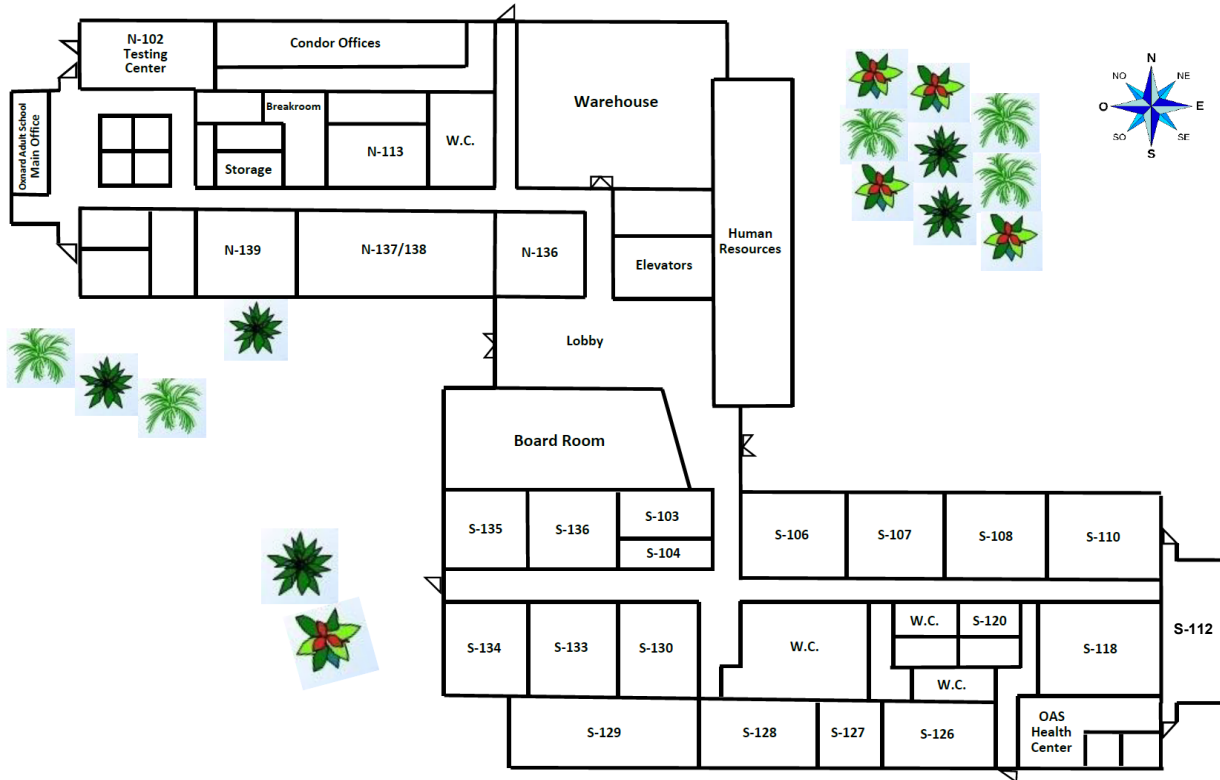

- Unlawful discrimination, harassment, intimidation, or bullying based on characteristics such as Age, Ancestry, Disability, Ethnic Group, Gender, Gender Expression, Gender Identity, Marital Status, Parenting, Nationality, National Origin, Race, Religion, Sex, Sexual Harassment, Sexual Orientation.
- Bullying not based on the above characteristics.
- Retaliation against a complainant or participant in the complaint process or anyone reporting a violation.
