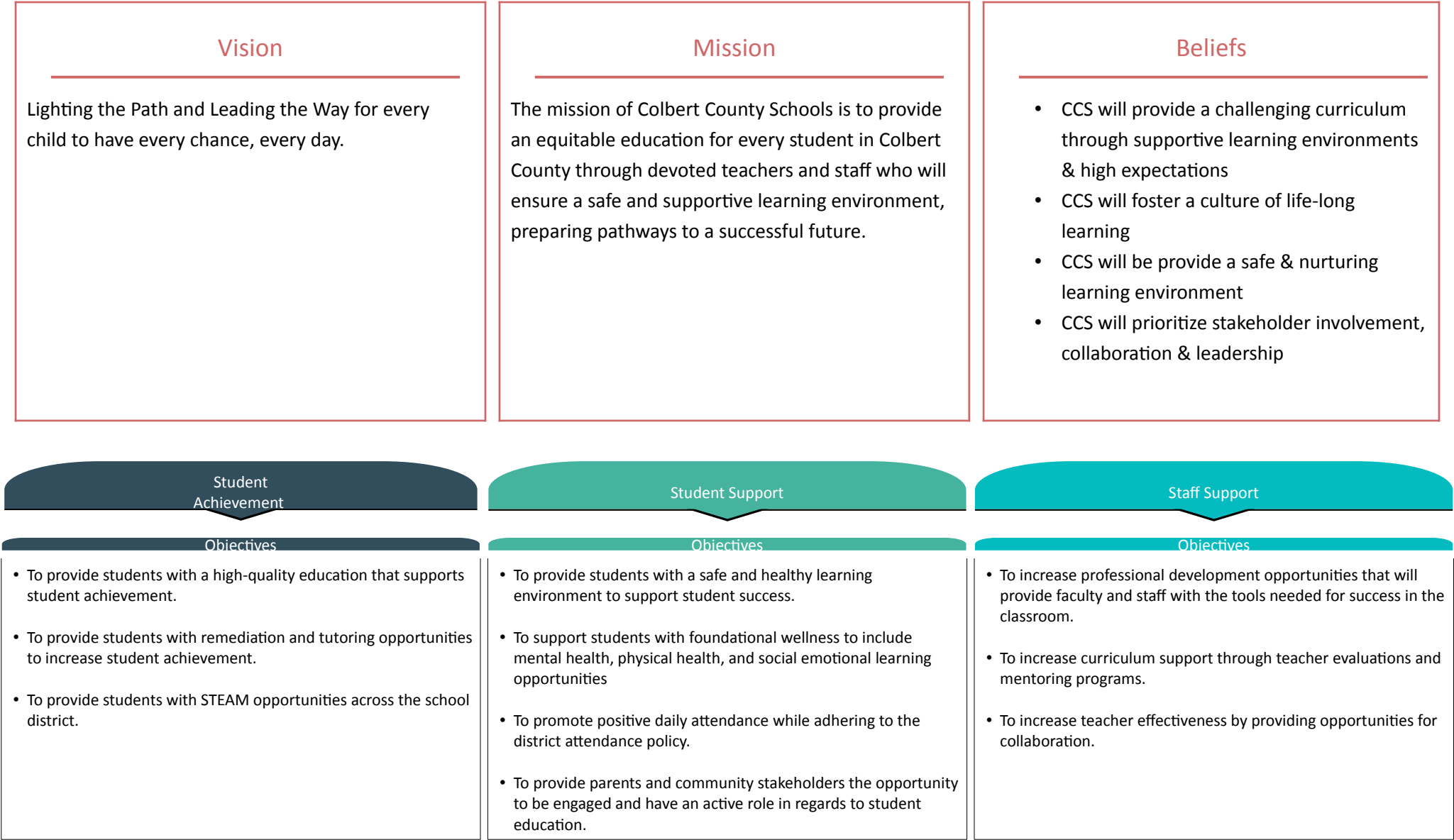


2025-2026 CES Continuous Improvement Plan
