### Becoming and Maintaining NJHS Membership

NJHS membership is offered to qualified 7th-grade students after the 4th six weeks report cards are printed. Students will be invited via a personal letter delivered during the school day. Details regarding induction and membership expectations will be included in invitation letters.

Membership is based on at least a 3.75 grade point average (GPA) and behavior conduct records. Names are gathered from a Katy ISD-generated report of students' GPA and conduct history. If you would like to determine if your child will be eligible, the formula for grade points given per class can be found in the Katy ISD Course Catalog (GPA-exempt courses are not factored in determining GPA.) Students with discipline infractions throughout the year are subject to removal from the list.

### Members Requirements:

Members are required to complete a minimum of 10 service hours each year, with at least 1 of those hours in service through the school. Students will be recognized for time given in service at the end of the year (if the minimum time is met).
