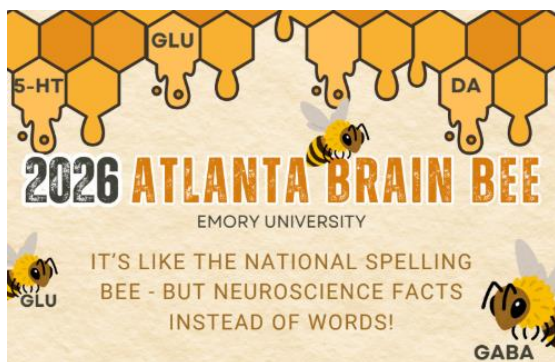

The **Atlanta Regional Brain Bee Competition** this year will be held at Emory University on **Saturday, March 7th** from **9:00AM-1:00PM**. The format of the Brain Bee Competition will consist of a preliminary written round (multiple-choice and short answer questions) and a final oral round. To prepare, participants are encouraged to participate in our **workshops (January 17th and 31st)** led by graduate students from Emory University and Georgia State University. **Attending the workshops is NOT a prerequisite for competing in the Brain Bee** and students may attend the workshops **WITHOUT** competing in the Brain Bee. Workshops are \$40 per person per workshop however, discounted group rates and tuition assistance is available for

students who qualify for the National Free or Reduced Lunch Program at their school.

Our mission is to motivate students to learn about the brain and to inspire them to pursue careers in neuroscience so they can help treat and find cures for brain disorders. There are three tiers to this competition: students compete at their Local Brain Bee (Atlanta), the local winners then compete at the National Brain Bee, and National Brain Bees send one representative to compete at the International Brain Bee (IBB) World Championship.

- **Early submission of manuscripts** is encouraged. Applicants who submit a manuscript by January 19, 2026 (11:59 PM, EST) will be invited to a writing workshop and will have the **opportunity to revise and resubmit** your manuscript by the February 16, 2026 submission deadline.
- **All manuscripts must be submitted by February 16, 2026 (11:59 PM, EST)**
