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Step 3 <input type="checkbox"/>	<p>COMPLETE APPLICATION: Paper applications will be provided at the applicant orientation session. You must submit the completed program application to Meridian’s Career Planning Center (CPC) to be considered. Incomplete applications will not be considered.</p>																											
Step 4 <input type="checkbox"/>	<p>SUBMIT SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION TO MERIDIAN’S CAREER PLANNING CENTER (CPC):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Official college transcript(s), from an ARRT accepted accredited college or university, with documentation of degree. If you are participating in the NOC Articulation Agreement, you will also need to submit a degree audit with your official transcript. ➤ Documentation for prerequisite courses, in Anatomy & Physiology and Medical Terminology. Documentation must include official transcript showing completion of these courses or completion certificates from an Oklahoma Career and Technology Education Center with proof of a grade of “C” or higher. ➤ ACT scores, if applicable (SAT equivalency may apply) ➤ WorkKeys Assessment Certificate, if applicable. <i>WorkKey testing (3 assessments in applied math, workplace documents, and graphic literacy) is offered at Meridian Technology Center. The three exams are to be completed at one setting. Please call the Program Administration Office for testing dates, appropriate fees, and to sign up.</i> ➤ Documentation of any current health careers certification(s), if applicable. ➤ Documentation of completion of any other college course(s) in Biology, Chemistry, or Mathematics, if applicable. <p>All information must be complete and accurate to be considered applicable to the selection process. (<i>See the Applicant Selection Criteria for points assigned to each category. The Applicant Selection Criteria is reviewed annually for revision.</i>)</p>																											
Step 5 <input type="checkbox"/>	<p>COMPLETE ARRT PRE-ELIGIBILITY APPLICATION, if applicable:</p> <p>In accordance with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologist (ARRT) eligibility requirements for certification, a candidate must be a person of good moral character and be in compliance with the ARRT Standards of Ethics. You may contact the ARRT at https://www.arrt.org or (651) 687-0048 to obtain a ruling for any of the following situations that may have an impact on your eligibility for registration and certification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Charged or convicted of a crime, including a felony, a misdemeanor, court convictions or military court martial. • Disciplinary actions by a regulatory authority or certification board. 																											

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Withdrawn or been suspended, dismissed, or expelled from an education program that you attended in order to meet ARRT certification requirements. <p>Eligibility for certification may influence your decision in completing the application process. A prior conviction is not a component of the selection criteria used for admissions to the radiologic technology program. Eligibility for admissions to clinical sites providing training are established by each medical institution affiliated with the radiologic technology program. Contact the radiologic technology program coordinator for more information.</p>
Step 6 <input type="checkbox"/>	APPLICATION & SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS DEADLINE: All materials required for application to the radiologic technology program must be submitted to Meridian Technology Center's Career Planning Center (CPC) on or before the APPLICATION DEADLINE of Monday, June 1, 2026, by 5PM.
Step 7 <input type="checkbox"/>	INTERVIEW: Class size is limited to ensure that optimal supervision and educational opportunities are available. The highest ranked applicants, based on the accumulative points identified in the Applicant Selection Criteria, will progress to the next phase in the selection process. These applicants will be contacted to schedule an interview with the selection committee. Participation in the interview does not automatically grant acceptance into the program. Dependent upon class size, the highest ranked applicants will be selected for program admission. Customarily 12-14 students each year. INTERVIEWS are scheduled during the week of June 8-12, 2026, and are held on Meridian's Stillwater campus.
Step 8 <input type="checkbox"/>	NOTIFICATION OF SELECTION STATUS: Applicants will be notified of their selection status (accepted, alternate or not accepted) by letter. All decisions made by the selection committee are final.
Step 9 <input type="checkbox"/>	COMPLETE PROCESS: Accepted students must complete a Career Program Enrollment form in the Career Planning Center and pay a deposit by a date that will be indicated in acceptance letter.
