

PUBLIC SOLICITATIONS OR ADVERTISING IN THE SCHOOLS

- I. School facilities, staff and school children shall not in any manner advertise or otherwise promote any commercial, political or non-school agency, individual or organization in the schools.

- II.
 - A. The Superintendent is hereby granted the authority to approve activities in cooperation with any individual or organization in promoting activities of general public interest which promote the education or other best interest of students.

 - B. In case of colleges, universities, armed service agencies, corporations, business and public service agencies, access to the schools shall be encouraged to bring career/occupational information to the students. The Superintendent or his/her designee shall ensure that such activities are carefully monitored to restrict any commercial advertisement.

 - C. No person or outside organization may circulate or distribute any material throughout the school, without prior approval of the Superintendent or his/her designee.
