

QUALIFICATION OF A BOARD OF EDUCATION MEMBER

A Board of Education member must meet the following qualifications:

- A. Must be a qualified voter of the Waterville Central School District (the District); that is, a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years of age or older, and not adjudged to be an incompetent; (Note: a convicted felon is barred from running for a seat on a Board if their maximum prison sentence has not expired or if he or she has not been pardoned or discharged from parole.).
- B. Able to read and write.
- C. The only family member of the household on the school Board.
- D. A legal resident of the District for at least a continuous and uninterrupted period of one (1) year prior to the election.
- E. May not simultaneously hold another incompatible public office, including, but not limited to Superintendent, District Clerk, tax collector, treasurer or librarian, or any employee of the Board.
- F. Not a current employee of the District.
- G. May not have been removed from any school district office within one (1) year preceding the date of appointment or election to the Board.
