

BOARD MEMBER TRAINING

I. Statement of Policy

Newly elected members of the Board of Education (the Board), shall, within the first year of their term, complete the required training pursuant to NYS Education Law § 2102-a. Such training may be offered as part of a general course of training for the purpose of educating Board members on their powers, functions and duties.

II. Required Training

- A. A minimum of six hours of training on the fiscal oversight, accountability and fiduciary responsibilities of a school board member.
- B. A training course to acquaint the board member with the powers, functions and duties of the boards of education, as well as the powers and duties of other governing and administrative authorities affecting public education.
- C. Members of the Board are encouraged to continue training throughout their term of office.

III. Compliance

Members of the Board shall receive their training from approved providers. Each member of the Board shall file a certificate of completion of such course(s) with the Waterville Central School District Clerk.
