INFECTION CONTROL PROGRAM

- I. For the purpose of administering its Infection Control Program, the Waterville Central School District has identified the following employees/positions as those reasonably anticipated to have skin, eye, mucous membrane, or parenteral contact with blood or other potentially infectious materials that may result from the performance of their duties:
 - A. School Nurse
 - B. Nurse's Aide
 - C. Employees trained in first-aid and designated by the Waterville Central School District as responsible for rendering medical assistance as part of their job duties.
 - D. Special Education Teachers, Teaching Assistants and Teacher Aides employed in the following programs: _____
 - E. All Operations and Maintenance Staff.

- II. It is recognized that employees within the same job title may have varying degrees of exposure to blood, body fluids or tissues. Any employee may seek review of the exposure category based on the responsibilities and functions of their position. Such request shall be made in writing to the Superintendent. In the event that the determination of the Superintendent is not satisfactory to the individual, he/she may forward such request for review to the Board of Education for final consideration and action.
